



Siena College requires Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) to log in to several web-based applications. You will need to download the Microsoft Authenticator App on your mobile device to authenticate your log in.

- MFA works to strengthen protection of both the College's data and your personal data.
- The use of MFA on your personal mobile device does not provide any financial impost to staff nor does it compromise your personal data, in fact, it works to protect your personal data.
- MFA will ask you to verify your log in only once each time you log into Office 365, Email, OneDrive, and Teams on each of the devices you use (e.g. laptop, mobile phone, desktop). Other web-based applications including Siena Central and SynWeb will have MFA added early next year.
- MFA will ask you to allow or deny access when you log in. If you receive a request to allow access but you are not attempting to log in, please do not allow access as this means that someone else is trying to log in to one of our platforms using your account. Please report any unauthorised log in attempts to IT Services and they will advise whether you should change your password.
